<p><b>5<sup>th</sup> Sunday after Pentecost</b>  <b>Proper 8</b>  <i>Pray on</i>  <i>July 1-3</i></p>	<p>Almighty God, you have built your Church upon the foundation of the apostles and prophets, Jesus Christ himself being the chief cornerstone: Grant us so to be joined together in unity of spirit by their teaching, that we may be made a holy temple acceptable to you; through Jesus Christ our Lord, who lives and reigns with you and the Holy Spirit, one God, for ever and ever. Amen.</p>
<p><b>6<sup>th</sup> Sunday after Pentecost</b>  <b>Proper 9</b>  <i>Pray on</i>  <i>July 4-10</i></p>	<p>O God, you have taught us to keep all your commandments by loving you and our neighbor: Grant us the grace of your Holy Spirit, that we may be devoted to you with our whole heart, and united to one another with pure affection; through Jesus Christ our Lord, who lives and reigns with you and the Holy Spirit, one God, for ever and ever. Amen.</p>
<p><b>7<sup>th</sup> Sunday after Pentecost</b>  <b>Proper 10</b>  <i>Pray on</i>  <i>July 11-17</i></p>	<p>O Lord, mercifully receive the prayers of your people who call upon you, and grant that they may know and understand what things they ought to do, and also may have grace and power faithfully to accomplish them; through Jesus Christ our Lord, who lives and reigns with you and the Holy Spirit, one God, now and for ever. Amen.</p>
<p><b>8<sup>th</sup> Sunday after Pentecost</b>  <b>Proper 11</b>  <i>Pray on</i>  <i>July 18-21, 23-24</i></p>	<p>Almighty God, the fountain of all wisdom, you know our necessities before we ask and our ignorance in asking: Have compassion on our weakness, and mercifully give us those things which for our unworthiness we dare not, and for our blindness we cannot ask; through the worthiness of your Son Jesus Christ our Lord, who lives and reigns with you and the Holy Spirit, one God, now and for ever. Amen.</p>
<p><b>Feast of Mary Magdalene</b>  <i>Pray on</i>  <i>July 22</i></p>	<p>Almighty God, whose blessed Son restored Mary Magdalene to health of body and of mind, and called her to be a witness of his resurrection: Mercifully grant that by your grace we may be healed from all our infirmities and know you in the power of his unending life; who with you and the Holy Spirit lives and reigns, one God, now and for ever. Amen.</p>
<p><b>9<sup>th</sup> Sunday after Pentecost</b>  <b>Proper 12</b>  <i>Pray on</i>  <i>July 25, 27-31</i></p>	<p>O God, the protector of all who trust in you, without whom nothing is strong, nothing is holy: Increase and multiply upon us your mercy; that, with you as our ruler and guide, we may so pass through things temporal, that we lose not the things eternal; through Jesus Christ our Lord, who lives and reigns with you and the Holy Spirit, one God, for ever and ever. Amen.</p>
<p><b>Feast of St. James, Apostle</b>  <i>Pray on</i>  <i>July 26</i></p>	<p>O gracious God, we remember before you today your servant and apostle James, first among the Twelve to suffer martyrdom for the Name of Jesus Christ; and we pray that you will pour out upon the leaders of your Church that spirit of self-denying service by which alone they may have true authority among your people; through Jesus Christ our Lord, who lives and reigns with you and the Holy Spirit, one God, now and for ever. Amen.</p>
